The criteria for selecting the Consultants are: -

**Minimum qualification requirements**

***Mandatory***

- a. A minimum qualification of master’s degree in architecture or civil engineering or similar qualification from a recognized institution.
- b. Relevant experience in civil, engineering and architecture and infrastructure development including building and construction.
- c. Experience working on WB-financed projects or similar (other Multilateral Donor Banks, bilateral donors) with particularly exposure to E&S considerations including stakeholder consultations in support of engineering decision-making would be an added advantage. Experience with technical and environmental, social, health and safety compliance monitoring of infrastructure projects in line with WB standards and Good International Industry Practice.
- d. Experience in contract management of infrastructure projects.
- e. Demonstrated ability to address technical issues relating to building and construction works

***Desirable***

- At least 3 years and above, Experience in implementing, maintaining, and supporting a variety of Project Control and Construction Management Systems (project, risk, quality, finance, reporting, and information management).
- The Infrastructure Adviser shall have the following professional competencies:
  - i) Sound of scientific and technical knowledge.
  - ii) Analytical skills.
  - iii) Confidence and leadership skills.
  - iv) Effective organizational skills.
  - v) Ability to work and communicate with multi-disciplinary teams in a project set up.
  - vi) Strong interpersonal skills and management skills with a role in assisting internal and external clients.
